

St Peters Anglican Church Nile

WW1 Honour Roll made from illuminated paper is in a glazed frame. At the top is a Christian Cross surmounting a rising sun badge. There is a large Australian blue ensign and Union Jack on the sides of the Honour Roll. The Honour Roll was designed and illuminated by Emilie R Barney.

Underneath the badge is the following inscription:

In Grateful Memory Of The Men Of Nile Park Who Gave Their
Lives For Their Country In The Great War 1914 – 1918

Below the list of the fallen are a group of flags of the allied nations; Great Britain, Belgium, Serbia and France. This is followed by the following inscription:

Their Name Liveth for Evermore
O Risen Lord, O Shepherd Of Our Dead
Whose Cross Has Bought Them And Whose Staff Has Led
In Glorious Hope Their Proud And Sorrowing Land
Commits Her Children To Thy Gracious Hand
